(S.2235 Gounardes/A.3506 Reyes)

vs.

**LOCAL COPS LOCAL CRIMES**  
(Hochul)



Ends 287(g) contracts between state and local law enforcement and federal immigration agents.

\*expires in 3 years



Bars ICE agents from entering nonpublic areas of government run "sensitive locations," like schools and public hospitals, without a judicial warrant.

\*expires in 3 years



Bars ICE agents from entering nonpublic areas of **all government run locations** – including the DMV, social services offices, and more.



Bans all collusion – with or without contracts – between nearly all state and local government agencies and ICE and CBP.



Bans all state and local agencies – including schools, hospitals, and shelters – from colluding and sharing sensitive information with ICE.



Prohibits local law enforcement from asking about someone's immigration status in most circumstances.



Creates a process to secure databases and limit ICE and CBP access to state information databases.



Ensures that people in custody are given notice of their rights before being interviewed by ICE.



Enacts **permanent legal protections for immigrants** – with no expiration date.
